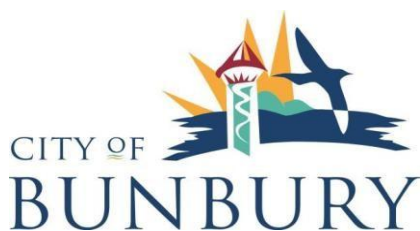

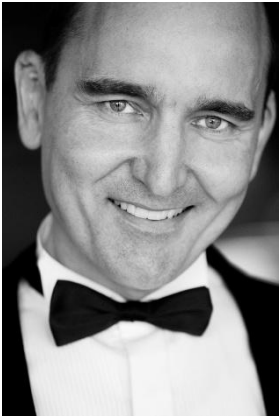

Robert has performed over 20 roles with West Australian Opera, including Dr. Bartolo in *The Marriage of Figaro*, Don Basilio in *The Barber of Seville*, Dulcamarra in *The Elixir of Love* and Koko in *The Mikado*. He performed two roles in the highly acclaimed Australian premier of *The Trail* by Philip Glass for Lost and Found Opera at the 2026 Perth Festival. He was the Prison Warden in *Dead Man Walking* with Freeze Frame Opera which won Best Production (Opera/Musical Theatre/Cabaret) in the 2026 Performing Arts WA Awards. For the same company he has performed many roles including The Commendatore in *Don Giovanni* and the title role in *Gianni Schicchi*.

As a concert soloist with the St Georges Cathedral Consort under the direction of Dr Joseph Nolan Robert has performed Handel's Sampson, *Messiah*, Mozart Requiem, Bach's Passions among other works . He also been engaged as a soloist with Perth Symphonic Chorus, UWA Choral Society and Perth Symphony Orchestra.

His musical theatre credits include Barry Fife in *Strictly Ballroom* (Drew Anthony Creative), Cinderella's Father in *Into the Woods* (West Australian Opera) and *Cinderella Pantomime* (Zealous Productions.) Robert is an award-winning cabaret performer having appeared at Downstairs at the Maj, The Ellington, Perth Writers' Festival, Perth Fringe World, Busselton Fringe, Edinburgh Fringe and off-Broadway New York City in his shows such as *What the Fandango?!* and *Mismatched* (with Penny Shaw.)

Robert holds a Bachelor of Music Education from the University of Western Australia and a Diploma of Opera from Sydney Conservatorium. As a singing teacher his many years' experience includes teaching at WAAPA, Hale School, Prendiville Catholic College and from his home studio in North Perth.

VICTORIA NEWTON



Victoria Newton has been serenading audiences for many years here in Perth, and also in the UK where she was recognised as one of the most exciting and dynamic singers on the London jazz scene.

Victoria's musical journey began in Perth, and whilst studying a Bachelor of Music majoring in Clarinet at the University of Western Australia, she discovered an enormous passion for jazz. She then went on to study jazz voice at the Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts where she had the most amazing opportunity to support international artists such as Ray Charles, Dionne Warwick, Ray Brown and James Moody as lead vocalist with the Western Australian Youth Jazz Orchestra.

During her early years in London Victoria collaborated with Acid-Jazz recording artist, the late Ronny Jordan for various performances, and supported Terence Blanchard at the Jazz Café with her quartet. She has appeared at many venues and festivals in the UK and Europe including the famous Ronnie Scott's Jazz Club in London, The London International Jazz Festival, The Soho Jazz Festival, The Oxford Literary Festival, The Ingolstadt Jazz Festival in Germany, and Alexis Jazz Club in Kuala Lumpur for their International Jazz Series. One of her most cherished gigs to date has been performing her favourite songs from Brazil whilst cruising up the Amazon!

Victoria also experienced international success during the mid 1990s with UK dance/pop group Strike and their massive hit 'U Sure Do'. The success of this single followed by 4 UK top 40 hits and the critically acclaimed album 'I Saw the Future' led to a whirlwind of TV appearances including MTV and BBC's Top of the Pops, tours to many countries around the world, and performances alongside the likes of Jocelyn Brown, Tina Arena, Rozalla, The Back Street Boys and The Spice Girls!

After many years of the touring and recording electronic dance music, Victoria released her first jazz album, 'The Song is You' in 2004 which received regular airplay in the UK and featured some of the finest British musicians including the internationally acclaimed Gwilym Simcock.

Victoria heads the jazz vocal program and teaches on both the jazz and contemporary vocal courses at the Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts.
